## WHAT IS FIRE AND ICE?

Fire and Ice is a winter camp organised for Scouts, Guides, Explorers, and The Senior Section. We are going as a Girlguiding Buckinghamshire County Group; Guides, TSS and adults all welcome (you can come with or without your Unit Leader).

## WHAT CAN I DO AT FIRE AND ICE?

## CAMP SECURITY

At Fire and Ice all campers are provided with a camp lanyard to show that they are meant to be at camp. These have a plastic wallet which will hold permission forms required for some of the activities and personal health forms. The service crew will challenge anyone not wearing either a camp lanyard or a visitor's pass.

## CATERING AT FIRE AND ICE

We will be taking advantage of the full catering option (hence the early deadline) it'll include all meals on Saturday and breakfast and lunch on Sunday it'll probably will be a good idea to have a BIG roast dinner in the oven waiting for you when you get home as you'll be cold and hungry!!! Please make sure you eat a HOT meal before you arrive.

## SNACKS AT FIRE AND ICE?

There are snack waggons that sell fast food, doughnuts and hot chocolate for you to purchase if you want.

## CAMP FEE

The cost includes your camp fee, activities and meals/hot drinks, a badge and admin/first aid costs. If you are an adult who wants to come but you are not going to take part in the activities then your fee will be reduced by £17 (so you need to pay £43), please indicate this on your application form. If you came last year your fee is reduced by £4 (as you already have a Girlguiding Bucks woolly hat £56).

## BP ADVENTURE

If you'd like to use this for your BP Adventure Challenge please indicate on the application form, your Guide Leader will need to sign to approve this.

## KIT

Full kit list will be sent with consent forms at the end of December, please be aware that you will need the following: base layers (top and bottoms), 2 pairs of gloves (including one waterproof pair – ski glove type), waterproof jacket and trousers, walking boots (not shoes or trainers), 2 sleeping bags, one 4 season, hot water bottle with cover (tested for leaks!), fleece or cotton liner or both, bivvy or survival bag or both and a head torch.
