Girlguiding UK Contingent Management Team Member: Role Description

A World Scout Moot is an opportunity for 18 - 25 year old members of guiding and scouting to meet up, share stories and strengthen international understanding. The next Moot is being hosted by the Association des Scouts du Canada from 8 - 18 July 2013. It will bring together 5,000 young people from around the world.

Together with The Scout Association, it is hoped that Girlguiding UK members will participate in the MOOT and to help plan and prepare for the event, The Scout Association is putting together a Contingent Management Team. They will start planning in 2012 and will help to ensure that the UK Contingent has the best possible experience at the Moot.

We are seeking to fill the role of Girlguiding UK member on the UK Contingent Management Team for the 14th World Scout Moot, to be held in Canada in 2013.

**The role of the Guide Representative on the CMT is likely to include:**

- Working with other members of the UK CMT on all aspects of the preparations and training for all members of the UK Contingent.
- Encouraging the integration of members of Girlguiding UK into the UK Contingent.
- Working with the Girlguiding UK PR team to provide PR and Media advice to the UK Contingent Leader relating to Girlguiding UK.
- The preparation of articles for promoting the event in *guiding* magazine and on the website and e-newsletters.
- The procurement and preparation of Girlguiding UK promotional gifts, information and display material.
- Advice on insurance, forms and qualifications required by Girlguiding UK participants.
- Ensuring that the Risk Assessment and the Critical Incident Plan carried out for the event is suitable for those representing Girlguiding UK.
- Providing advice and guidance on Girlguiding UK regulations.

- Must have experience of working with Senior Section age range
- Experienced camper and holder of Camp Licence
- Experience of International travel
- Must hold or be working towards International endorsements
- Experience of managing people
- Good health and reasonable physical stamina!
- Organisational and budgetary skills
- Experience with large scale events (preferably joint events with TSA)
- Computer literacy is vital
- Daily access to the internet and email essential
- Access to broadband connection beneficial
- Training experience beneficial
- Counselling skills beneficial
- Sound reasoning and judgement skills

In particular, candidates are advised that meetings of the World Scout MOOT CMT can be frequent and many are for a full weekend. Additionally there are selection weekends for the Contingent Support Team (CST) and weekends are also spent training and preparing these participants for the event. Conference calls are also utilised in preparing for Moot. After the event, promoting the event at the annual Gilwell Reunion is expected and there is also likely to be at least one weekend of evaluation work after the event.
